

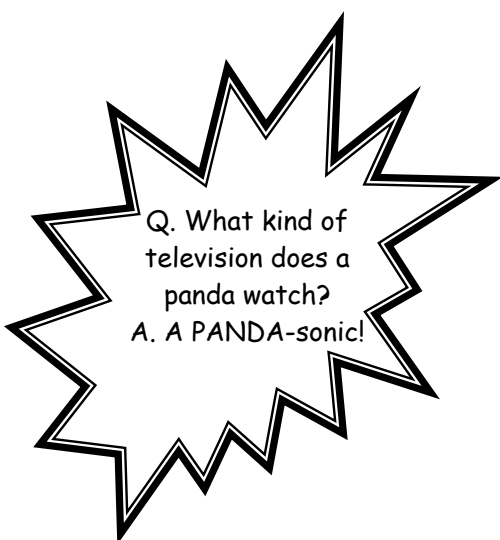
## CONGRATULATIONS to all Art Show Participants!
